Tim "The Ranger" Sullivan



Tim "The Ranger" Sullivan passed away unexpectedly at age 60 while out for a run on September 24th, 2007. He was the father of Festival Director Matt Sullivan and his brothers Andy and Mike, and was an active committee member since the inception of the Great American Irish Festival. Known for his work ethic and dedication to public service, Tim was raised on his parents' dairy farm in Schuylers, NY. He enlisted in the Marine Corps at age 17 and was a combat veteran of the Vietnam War. He joined the New York State Police in 1970, serving Herkimer and Oneida counties as Trooper, Sergeant and Investigator with distinction for 27 years. He later "hit for the cycle" by also working in law enforcement at the federal, county and local level. An active outdoorsman, the Ranger was also an avid runner throughout his lifetime and competed in many local running events. Since the Ranger's state police shield number was "3115", the race course has been set at 3.115 miles, just a bit longer than a 5K run. This race is dedicated to his memory and the memory of all of those who have proudly served.
